SECRETARY'S REPORT

Season 2022

It seems to be the norm the last few years when writing my report that we have had an interrupted season. This year it wasn't covid, but rain that caused us to have difficulties in providing a complete season. In fact we had a total of 7 weeks where all games were washed out and unfortunately even one grand final game was washed out.

We began the year with a very successful combined Season Launch and Presentation night which was well attended.

Despite the problems of the previous two seasons and the predicted loss of players we were pleased to be able to field 6 senior grades with some clubs able to field two teams in a grade. We welcomed a new club to our Association, the Lake Camels which combined the Lakers and University clubs although the wet season meant they didn't get to host games



at their home ground of Pendlebury Oval. However, our junior numbers were not great and we need to look at ways to recruit more players with the aim to have clubs with full junior teams in each age group.

Unfortunately, as the season was to begin continuous rain left fields unplayable and we postponed our competition start date but the wet weather continued throughout winter causing many washouts, changes to the draw, switching of grounds and inevitably changing the date and structure of our final series. Many thanks to those clubs that offered their grounds up for games when others' home grounds were unplayable.

Thank fully we were able to salvage an almost full season culminating in two big grand final days in September although as was with most of the season it was a rainy weekend and the 5th grade game had to be abandoned and the Sunday games transferred to Belmont. The Board would like to congratulate and thank the Belmont club volunteers who created a great Major League grand final day at such short notice.

On the bright side after two missed years we were able to get back to representative baseball with teams competing in the State Championships, and the Junior, Senior and Women's Country Championships. Congratulations to our Little League team that represented at the Nationals and also to both our men's Senior A & B teams which were crowned Country Champions in August.

Season 2023 will once again see the introduction of a new online registration system which I have been assured is the best yet and easiest to use and a long-term proposal. Clubs will need to get this up and running ASAP and take full advantage of its many different features.

This year was the first full year where we insisted on each coach having the appropriate accreditation, a BNSW requirement. We will be monitoring this more strictly next year, so I suggest the off season is a good time to recruit more coaches to do the online component of the course ready for our season.

On closing I would like to offer some thanks, firstly to my fellow Board members for their diligent work this season at times under difficult circumstances, with a special mention to Duane and Travers who I could call on at any stage for advice and assistance to make my work easier and for their hard work rescheduling the draw and fields in such a disrupted season, also thank you to Brian for capably covering my job whilst I was on holidays.

Thank you to the Newcastle District Softball Association for allowing us the use of their clubhouse.

Thank you for your service to John Wingrove who is stepping down after devoting many years as our delegate on the CLSC.

Lastly a big THANK YOU must go to our generous Sponsors, umpires, club committees, players and parents that all worked with us to make 2022 happen.

Over the last 10 years we have focussed on the culture of the team, respecting the game and playing in spirit that reflected well upon Newcastle. This year we had a large contingent of rookies, and given the 2 year break, there was a concern around if the culture would need to be re-established. Women's Representative Report

The Newcastle Open Women's team was comprised of 14 players this year, with 7 rookies, including a mother/daughter combo. The team enjoyed the weekend away competing and playing the game we love, however our overall result did not go our way, but providing us with a strong foundation to build on for next year.

Our first game, against Illawarra, resulted in a 12-all draw, with Ebony Van Eynde hitting two doubles and batting in five runs. Olivia Cameron hit a double and a single, driving in 3 runs. Kristy Frame and Karen Jones combined to pitch 2.2 innings, keeping us in the game and allowing us to not burn pitchers for future games. We lost our second game 8-6 to Fury. Alyssa Frame pitched 1 inning, for 4 hits and 2 strikeouts. Ebony pitched 2 innings throwing 45 pitches for 31 strikes, striking out 6 batters of 9 faced. Mikayla Tomlins caught great, as well as hitting a single and double and batting in 2 runs.

Our third game, against Tamworth, was a must win game to make it into the finals, pending other games out of our control. We defeated Tamworth 18 runs to 5, however this was not enough for us to make the 1v2 final. Although, this was the best game the team for the whole tournament. Karen pitched 2.1 innings, allowing only 2 hits. Alyssa came in to close the game for the final two outs, facing 3 batters and not allowing a run. Every player reached first safely at least once with almost every player driving in a run. Mattea fielded well at shortstop with 3 assists and a put out.
