Senior League players that play up in senior grades must not pitch in both leagues, so senior coaches need to be aware of their junior players and what they have done in their morning games.

If player pitches a major assignment he/she must leave the game and not play for the rest of the weekend.

The first few weeks of the competition for juniors will be gala days whilst players are missing at the State Championships. No junior games at Easter or the middle week of the school holidays.

We will wait and have a look at the standard of our Little League players and make changes to the rules as the season goes on.

Our aim is to get kids to love baseball and just getting them a game on weekends so please share players if your opposition is short.

4 REPRESENTATIVE NEWS

Baseball Australia wanted to change the Defensive Out requirements for Little League. BNSW after consultation with Associations have decided that NSW will NOT enforce DO requirements at the State Championships and that we will run our events in accordance with Little League International rules. However, teams that advance to the Nationals will need to follow the new rules.

For those not aware Newcastle has merged with the Central Coast for the 2023 State Championships. The team will be called Hunter Coast and new uniform tops have been ordered. We will still compete as Newcastle at the Country Championships. We may need to play an extra comp at the end of our season Sept-Oct to fulfil our 12 game charter.
